

THE DOME COVID POLICIES

Abusive and aggressive actions and words toward The Dome's employees will not be tolerated. Should anyone have an issue with the current COVID policies please contact mikeala@thedomereddeer.com in a professional and respectful manner. Failure to maintain respect in conversations may result in being removed from the facility and prohibited from entering the structure for up to 2 weeks or the cancellation of the rental. This is a stressful time for all, and The Dome Management is doing its best to comply with the ever-changing COVID guidelines put forward by the Province of Alberta.

Below you will find the current policies of The Dome Red Deer. These will be made effective November 3, 2020.

DOMESTAFF

I. COACHES

- a. Coaches are required to wear a mask when unable to maintain social distancing

II. FRONT COUNTER STAFF

- a. Front Counter staff are required to wear a mask whenever social distancing is not able to be maintained

III. FIELD HOUSE STAFF

- a. Field House staff are required to wear a mask when social distancing is not able to be maintained

DOMECLEANING POLICIES

I. HARD STRUCTURE

- a. Increased cleaning of all high-touch surfaces such as doors, counters, and bathrooms.

II. FIELD HOUSE

- a. Increased cleaning of all high-touch surfaces such as doors, benches, and equipment.
- b. All balls are cleaned in between each group usage

GENERAL: All people entering The Dome hard structure and field house are required to abide by the following guidelines:

I. COMPLAINTS

- a. Abusive and aggressive actions and words toward The Dome's employees will not be tolerated. Should anyone have an issue with the current COVID policies please contact mikeala@thedomereddeer.com in a professional and respectful manner.

Failure to maintain respect in conversations may result in being removed from the facility and prohibited from entering the structure for up to 2 weeks or the cancellation of the rental. II. SANITIZATION PROCEDURES

a. Hand Hygiene:

- i. Upon entry of the hard structure everyone must either sanitize or wash their hands before proceeding to the check in desk
- ii. Upon exit from the field house, everyone is required to sanitize their hands

III. MASK POLICY

- a. The Dome requires that all people not able to maintain proper social distancing measures and who are not a part of a sport cohort participating in activities at The Dome to wear a mask while inside the hard structure or field house.

IV. MOVEMENT WITHIN THE FACILITY

a. Hard structure:

- i. All people entering and exiting the Dome are required to use the doors marked “entry” and “exit” according to their entering and exiting of the building
- ii. All people must follow the arrows on the floor to help limit interactions between those entering and exiting the Field House and Hard Structure
- iii. Social distancing is required between all people entering The Dome and within the hard structure (including but not limited to, the café, birthday room, and change rooms).

b. Field House:

- i. All people entering and exiting the Field House must not crowd the doorway.
- ii. All people must maintain social distancing measures while in the field house unless they are a part of a sport cohort (parents and spectators are **NOT** included in the cohorts)
- iii. All people exiting the Field House must sanitize before using the doors
- iv. Masks must be worn when going through the revolving door

V. SYMPTOMATIC PARTICIPANTS:

- a. According to the guidelines put out by AHS, we will require all symptomatic participants to immediately leave the facility while doing the following:
 - i. Putting on a mask immediately
 - ii. Sanitize their hands before and after touching anything
 - iii. Maintain social distancing measures at all times

DOMe RUN PROGRAMS

*Must follow all policies outlined under “SPECTATORS” and “GENERAL” in addition to the ones listed below

I. DOME COHORTS

- a. All cohorts must be screened for COVID symptoms each time they have a training session. The symptom checklist will be asked during attendance for each program
- b. Should a member of the cohort test positive, parents of the children who are deemed to have been in close contact, will be notified. Close contact is currently defined as the following:
 - i. Someone who provides care, lives with, or has close physical contact without the appropriate PPE
 - ii. Comes into direct contact with infectious body fluids
 - iii. Comes within 2 metres of them for more than 15 minutes

II. DOME “RETURN TO TRAIN” PROGRAMS:

- a. Social distancing will be maintained
 - i. Younger age groups (Intro to Baseball, U4-7 Grassroots Soccer, Future Athletes) will require one parent to participate to ensure social distancing is being followed by the child.
- b. Should a member of the cohort test positive, parents of the children who are deemed to have been in close contact, will be notified. Close contact is currently defined as the following:
 - i. Someone who provides care, lives with, or has close physical contact without the appropriate PPE
 - ii. Comes into direct contact with infectious body fluids
 - iii. Comes within 2 metres of them for more than 15 minutes

RENTALS AND EVENTS

*Must follow all policies outlined under “SPECTATORS” and “GENERAL” in addition to the ones listed below

I. MONITORING:

- a. All monitoring of symptoms and other COVID related regulations must be done by the rental themselves according to the guidelines put forth by the Province of Alberta for their specific activity

II. ARRIVAL AT FACILITY

- a. If participants are being dropped off at The Dome for a rental activity, they will not be allowed early entry to the Field House until the start time of their rental and no more than 5 minutes early into the Hard Structure in order to avoid over-crowding, unless given written permission by The Dome Management Staff.
- b. Loitering in the Hard Structure is not allowed at this time. If parents wish to sit at the Café they may do so with the understanding that the capacity limitation is 15 individuals and is on a first come, first serve basis.

SPECTATORS

I. RENTALS: No spectators are allowed at this time unless given written permission by The Dome Management. This will be communicated to everyone by their **governing sport organization** and not The Dome Staff.

- a. Should parents of small children be required to escort their child(ren) to their assigned field space, they may do so, but then they are required to leave immediately
- b. For streaming of games and practices, please contact your sport governing body as they are the ones who can request this to take place
- c. For any concerns or complaints about the current spectator policy, you are required to contact your **sport governing body** and not The Dome Front Counter staff.

II. DOME PROGRAMS/COHORTS: Max of 1 parent/spectator per family participating

- a. Spectators must maintain social distancing protocols while within the hard structure and the field house. Masks are highly recommended while watching and only required when going through the revolving door
